JDCM Linked Marker DNA Test Information

Test Result: probable normal **Test ID Number:** 6984
Type of Sample: Blood

Result Interpretation: 1-1 (probable normal) dogs are not expected to develop JDCM, nor are they expected to pass a JDCM-causing gene to their offspring. Due to the inherent nature of linked marker tests, there is a slight chance that a pattern 1-1 dog is a carrier of JDCM and an even smaller chance that a pattern 1-1 dog is affected (see JDCM linked marker DNA test FAQ sheet at www.pwdca.org or www.pwdfoundation.org).
